Application for STEM Scholarships

For the 2024-2025 academic year at OSU

Applications are being accepted for Zonta Club STEM scholarships made possible by fundraising and donations to the Zonta Club of Corvallis. These scholarships are earmarked for female students of junior or senior standing who are committed to a career in science, technology, engineering, or math. They offer \$1000 per term for 3 terms to help cover tuition, fees, books, and supplies that are charged to the recipient's account at OSU.

CRITERIA

Applicants for a Zonta Stem scholarship must meet the following qualifications:

1. Be committed to a career in science, technology, engineering, or math. Preference will be given to applicants entering a field or profession where women are underrepresented.
2. Have junior or senior standing entering the 2024 Fall Term and a minimum B- average in prerequisite and/or major courses. If the applicant has sophomore status at time of application, a list of 2024 Spring term coursework must be included in the application. **LBCC students who are transferring to OSU** in the fall of 2024 with junior or senior standing and meet other qualification criteria are eligible to apply.
3. Be dedicated to improving the lives of others and serving as a role model for other women. Students with volunteer or work experience that demonstrate these interests will be given preference.
4. Be living in Oregon and currently enrolled for a minimum of 12 credits at OSU or LBCC. Preference will be given to applicants demonstrating financial need.

ESSAY

Maximum length: one page; minimum font: 11 pt.

In the essay, applicants should provide a summary of their background and prior experiences that led them to choose their academic major. Career goals, career opportunities in their field of study, and the responsibilities their career may require should also be described. In addition, applicants should indicate how they propose to improve the lives of others and/or serve as a role model for other women.

ACADEMIC TRANSCRIPT

An **unofficial, full** transcript of all completed academic college or university work must be submitted with the application. **Winter term 2024 grades must be included.** A photocopy of an official transcript issued by the college or university is acceptable. A listing of courses and grades prepared by the applicant is **not** acceptable.

PLEASE NOTE: Scholarship application forms require completion of five specific items: 1) Personal contact information along with previous education, volunteer, and work experiences; 2) Financial Needs Statement, 3) A one-page essay, 4) Full official **or unofficial transcript of all college level work, and 5) Signed Application Checklist.**

Applications must be submitted by email to zontaapp@gmail.com by April 15, 2024. Complete instructions for submission can be found on page 4 of the application. Incomplete applications or applications that do not conform to all instructions **will not** be considered for a scholarship.

Unused scholarship funds cannot be extended and will be returned to the Zonta Service Foundation.

4. _____ Completed Application Checklist with applicant's signature and date.
